

USB Reader Software Driver Installation Instructions



1. Insert the CD, then locate and run the install program it contains, following these instructions precisely.



2. You must accept the license agreement before you will be allowed to proceed with the installation.



3. You will be given a choice to install two options. Leave both items checked, and click **NEXT**.



4. You will be warned that the USB reader must be unplugged if it is connected to your computer. **Make sure the reader is disconnected at this time.**



5. It will be necessary to select the destination folder for the software. As with most software installations, it is often best to use the default destination.



6. Confirm that you wish to proceed with the installation by clicking on **Next**.



7. After the installation begins, an error message will be generated. Simply click **CONTINUE**.




8. A warning message will state that the Java machine could not be located. Simply click **OK** to continue.




9. After some time, the installation routine will finish, and you will be prompted to connect the USB reader. Connect the reader to a USB port on the computer. **Do NOT connect the reader to a hub or docking station.**




10. Windows will then find the newly connected USB reader, and will open the wizard that adds new hardware to the system. Follow the on-screen directions to enable your computer to recognize the new USB reader as a hardware device.



11. Once the wizard finishes, you will continue with the USB reader installation program. The ***1-Wire Net Port Selection*** window allows for port setup. Click the **Auto-Detect** button. The software will find the reader.



12. When the reader is found, click on **Yes** to make the newly selected port the default connection for your USB reader.



13. The installation is now complete. Click **Close** to exit the installer program.
